Golfing Guests

Dear Ansley Visitor,

We are delighted to host you and our staff looks forward to being at your service! To help us make your visit the best it can be, please join us in observing some of the Club's courtesies and customs:

Attire

Proper attire is required on the golf course and range at all times. Shirts must remain tucked in at all times. No denim or warm-up suits are permitted. Collared shirts are required for men. Women may wear a sleeveless shirt provided it has a collar or a collarless blouse provided it has sleeves. Hats must be worn as designed and removed when in the clubhouse. Shorts must be Bermuda style in length for men and no more than 5 inches from the knee for women. Cargo shorts/pants are not allowed.

Cellular Phones

Out of respect for members and their guests, the use of cellular/mobile phones are not permitted in the Clubhouse. Members and guests may receive and send text messages and emails and may surf the web on cell phones, smart phones, or other handheld devices. Please be sure that all phones are on vibrate/silent during your visit.

Pace of Play

Players are expected to complete their round in 4 hours and 15 minutes or less. Ansley Golf Club takes pace of play very seriously - as a visiting group you should take special care to ensure you play as quickly as possible so as not to disrupt the experience of players behind you.

Food & Beverage

For your convenience, beverages and light snacks are available on the course. For additional fare, we suggest our on-the-course food ordering as an option. This is available through the beverage cart attendant, and will be ready when you have finished your round.

Other Information

- If signing something back to your club, please be sure your name and number are legible
- Smoking is prohibited indoors at both facilities
- The use of metal spikes and soft spikes with "flared" tips are prohibited

Parking and Bag Drop

To drop off your clubs, please pull into the valet located at the front of Ansley Golf Club. From there, our complimentary valet will gladly help you with your clubs and park your car. Your clubs will be taken directly to the Golf Pro Shop.

Parking and Bag Drop

Pull to the front of the clubhouse and you'll notice a bag drop sign. Leave your golf bags at the drop and press the button to notify the Golf Pro Shop that your clubs are ready at the bag drop. A member of the staff will pick up your bag from the bag drop and take it down the hill to the Golf Pro Shop.

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Tennis Guests

General Information

If you are joining a member for tennis, please sign in at the Pro Shop before proceeding to the courts. A member must invite you to be their guest to play at our facility.

For your convenience, our Club provides towels.

Dress Code

Tennis shoes are mandatory for all eight courts and the paddle court. Sleeveless shirts are prohibited at all times. Cleated sport shoes are prohibited for use on the courts.



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Pool Guests

General Information

If you are joining a member at the pool, please sign-in before entering the pool at either one of our gated pool entrances. A member must invite you to be their guest at our swimming pool.

For your convenience, our Club provides towels. Located by the restroom, you will find an attendant who will provide you with towels. Food and drinks are also available poolside.

Youth Swim Policy

When you come through the gate, you will need to identify any swimmer(s) you have with you that are 10 years and younger (even if they are not getting in the pool). The gate attendant will check the list to see if your swimmer(s) are already listed as a qualified swimmer. If your swimmer(s) are listed as qualified swimmer(s), you will be permitted through to the pool gate and will NOT have to wear an orange wrist band. If your swimmer(s) are NOT on the qualified swimmer(s) list the following steps will be taken:

1. You and the swimmer(s) you are responsible for will be required to wear an orange wrist band. While in the big pool, the responsible adult will be required to be in the pool with the swimmer(s) at all times and within arms reach of the unqualified swimmer(s).
2. You will have the option of having your swimmer(s) take a short swim test so their name(s) can be added to the list of qualified swimmers. Once the test is passed neither one of you will be required to wear the wrist band and their name(s) will be added to the list.

Swim Diapers

All children under the age of three are required to wear an Ansley approved swim diaper. These are reusable diapers made of impermeable fabric with elastic at the waist and legs. Approved swim diapers are for sale at the Towel Shop. The lifeguards will conduct diaper checks on a random basis.
